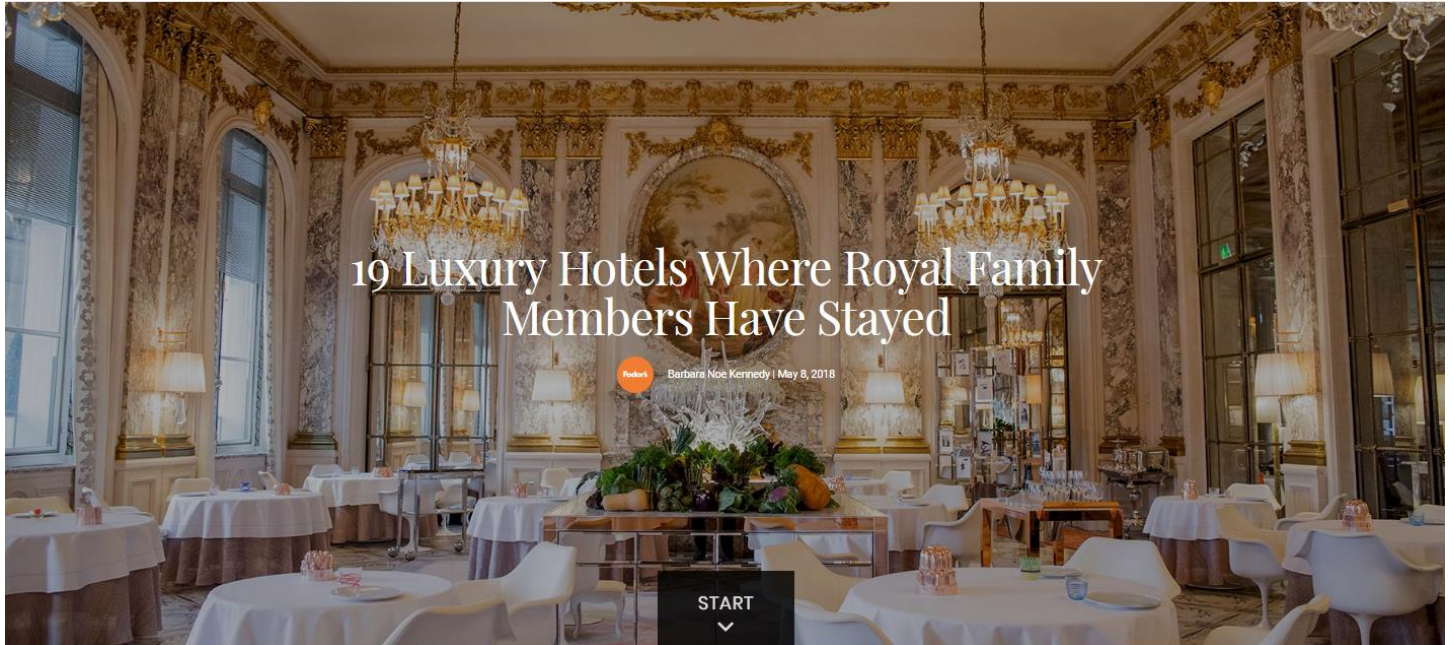

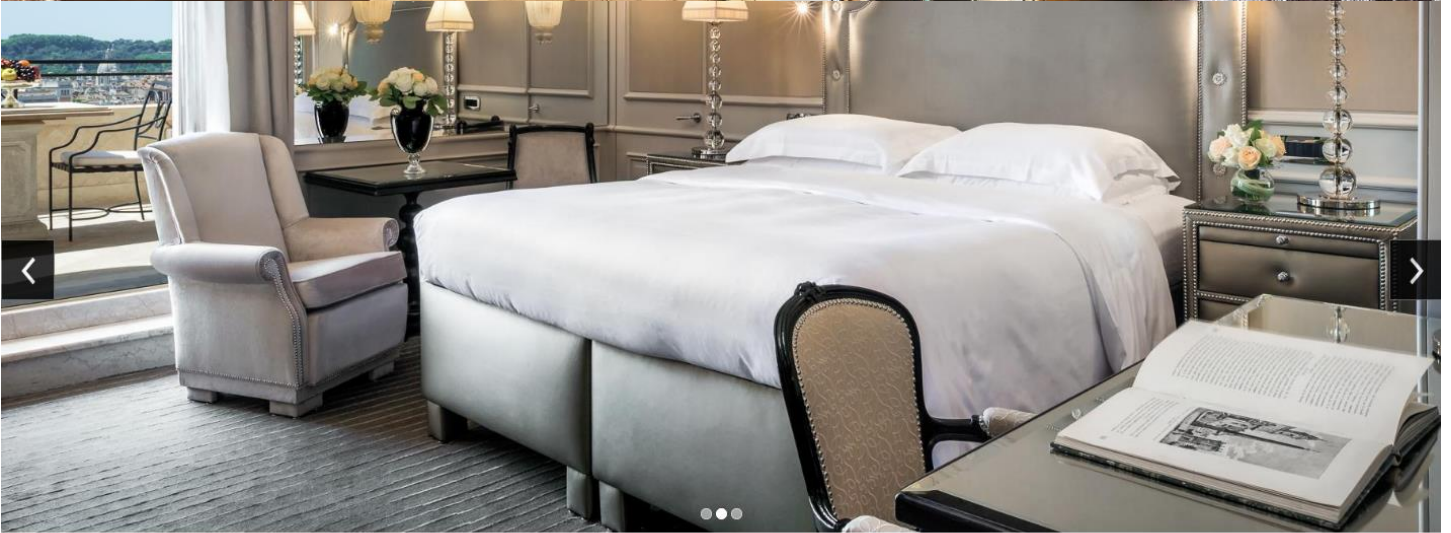

WHERE: Rome, Italy

Sitting at the top of the Spanish Steps in one of the most romantic settings in Italy, this historic hotel has been welcoming dignitaries and celebrities since the late 1800s. Given its devotion to exclusivity, a long line of royals has checked in as well, including Charles and Diana, King Gustaf VI Adolf of Sweden, Prince Felix de Luxembourg, King Juan Carlos I of Spain, and Prince Rainer of Monaco during his honeymoon with Grace Kelly. Old World elegance is the name of the game here, with a floor-to-ceiling marble lobby, art and antiques throughout, and magical views overlooking the Eternal City. Hassler Penthouse, featuring two master bedrooms, a fully equipped kitchen, and private elevator, is no doubt the royal accommodation of choice.
